

Louis E. Barrilleaux Scholarships

for Alpha Sigma Lambda Members

Current School of Continuing Studies students who are members of Alpha Sigma Lambda are eligible to apply for the Louis E. Barrilleaux Scholarships, awarded annually. Newly invited ASL inductees are also eligible to apply. At least one scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded at the ASL induction on Friday, April 3, 2009. Additional scholarship awards may be granted.

A brief application form is required (see next page). It is mailed to all ASL members & newly invited inductees, and it is also available for pickup at all School of Continuing Studies locations and on the website at www.scs.tulane.edu. It must be completed and returned to 125 Gibson Hall by Wednesday, March 25, 2009. Applications may be mailed, hand-delivered, or faxed.

Selection criteria for the scholarship include academic merit, earned credit hours at School of Continuing Studies, and the quality of the written personal statement submitted as part of the application.

The Louis E. Barrilleaux Scholarships are funded by the Davenport Family Fund, an endowed fund created through the generosity of SCS alumnus Joseph W. Davenport, Jr., UC '66. Davenport was inducted into ASL as an undergraduate. A strong proponent of lifelong learning, Davenport subsequently earned an MBA from Loyola University and a JD from the University of Georgia. He is retired from IBM Corporation, and is the president of Alternative Dispute Resolution, an arbitration and mediation firm in Mobile, AL. The scholarships are named in honor of the late UC Dean Louis E. Barrilleaux, who served as dean from 1981 to 1996. Additional gifts from Davenport and Barrilleaux's friends and family continue to support the scholarship fund.
