

## 2009 Harrah's Scholarship in Casino Resort Studies

The Harrah's Scholarships in Casino/Resort Studies at the Tulane University School of Continuing Studies were created in 2004 by a generous gift from the Harrah's Entertainment Foundation.

***The \$1,500 per year cash scholarships support the education of ethnic minority students (Hispanic, Asian, African-American, Native American, and others) enrolled in Casino Resort Studies at the School of Continuing Studies. Scholarships are renewable for up to 5 years for a total of \$7,500.***

***Deadline: To be received by January 15, 2009.***

### ***Scholarship Eligibility Criteria***

The applicant must:

- Be a part-time, currently enrolled School of Continuing Studies student **OR** be a newly accepted and enrolled part-time SCS student **OR** be a former SCS student who is re-enrolling in Spring 2009.
- Officially declare Casino Resort Studies as a major, minor, or post-baccalaureate certificate option prior to submitting this scholarship application.
- Complete all parts of the application and submit it so that it is **received** by the deadline date. Fax submissions are accepted; the fax number is (504) 865-5562. Late submissions will not be considered.
- Be a member of an under-represented ethnic minority within the Tulane student population.
- Demonstrate academic merit.

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee, and a telephone interview may be required. For 2009, more than one scholarship may be awarded. Applicants not selected to receive the award in 2009 may reapply in the future. Awards will be announced by January 23, 2009. Only the recipient(s) will be notified.

### ***Scholarship Terms***

- Awardee(s) will receive a \$1,500 cash award annually and must enroll in at least 2 semesters during the calendar year (any combination of spring, summer, or fall) following the awarding of the scholarship.
- The award is renewable for up to 5 years, provided the student maintains at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average and enrolls in at least two semesters of coursework each calendar year.
- Awardees must maintain status as a major, minor, or certificate student in Casino Resort Studies at the Tulane School of Continuing Studies.
- This award is made by Tulane University's School of Continuing Studies; it is **NOT** transferable to other programs of study or other institutions.
- Students who reside in the New Orleans area may be required to commute to the SCS Mississippi Coast Campus to complete certain required courses within the Casino Resort Studies program.
